Miss Railroad Day's Pageant - Rules, Regulations & Information

1. Contestants must compete in correct age division the day of pageant, if there is a dispute a birth certificate must be provided.
2. A contestant must be of good moral character, act in a ladylike manner, not married or have children.
3. Each age division must contain at least 3 contestants or the division will be combined or canceled and money refunded.
4. The pageant will be conducted under the rules and regulations established by Miss Railroad Day's Pageant directors and contestants agree to abide by these rules now in effect or announced thereafter. The decision of the judges will be final.
5. Should there be a problem of any kind during the pageant, or related events, the contestant is to go directly to a staff member and report the problem. Any unruly, unsportsmanlike, or unbecoming conduct by a contestant or any other member of her entourage, or any disregard for the rules and regulations of this pageant could result in immediate dismissal from competition without refund. (Parents, due to liability issues you must have your child under control while on stage.) Depending upon the severity of the action or behavior, it could result in a permanent barrier from future competitions in Miss Railroad Day's Pageant to be decided upon by the pageant directors.
6. Contestants agree to hold harmless Miss Railroad Day's Pageant, the GNCCC, pageant staff, and facilities from damages incurred through loss, theft, or injury caused by or during her participation in the pageant or related activities. I also understand that my picture may be printed for publicity. I hereby acknowledge that I have read the official rules and regulations of Miss Railroad Day's Pageant and that I will comply with them in every way, and that the personal data that I have submitted is true and correct.
7. Miss Photogenic photos must be turned in with application and fees. Only 3 1/2x5, 4x5, 5x7, or 8x10 pictures will be judged. Contestant; name and division should be on the picture back. Pictures can be picked up at the registration desk the day of the pageant.
8. Only one person will be allowed in the dressing room with contestants. It gets hot and crowded otherwise.
9. Miss Railroad Day's category winner will receive her \$250.00 scholarship at the end of her reign, providing she has fulfilled all duties set forth by the GNCCC and provides proof and information on what educational institution she will attend. The winners of each category duties will be; Attend Railroads Day's Festival Opening, Participate in the Miss Railroad Day's Parade, and attends other Railroad Day's Festival events. The Chamber must have current phone number and address during your reign. The Queen's may be invited (not mandatory) to attend other functions during her reign.
10. Division Queens are expected to crown the next year's winner and may not enter Miss Railroad Day's Pageant in the same age division again. The Queen's will not attend any functions representing Miss Railroad Day's without the permission of the GNCCC.
11. No refunds will be issued unless the pageant should be canceled.

Information

1. The deadline to enter the pageant is May 1, 2008. After this date a \$25.00 late fee is charged.
2. NO REHERSAL-Contestants will model a basic T pattern.
3. A photographer will be on hand to make pictures. Division Queens are encouraged to have their picture made before changing. Division Queens will receive a free photograph (not package). Miss Railroad Day's Pageant MUST have her picture made. The picture will be used for promotional ads.
4. No video cameras or flash photography will be allowed.
